

Middle school girls win Eastwood Relays, boys finish third

LUCKEY — Eastwood Middle School's girls track and field team won the Eastwood Relays Thursday night.

The Eagles won three of the 13 events and scored 110 points to edge Fremont by six points for first place in the eight-team meet.

The Eastwood boys finished third with 71 points, winning two events. Fremont won the meet with 96 points, while Bellevue was second with 84.

GIRLS RECAP

The Eagles won three field events and one running event.

The high jump team of Macy Shoemaker, Gabriella Provo and Olivia Nutter won with a combined height of 12-4.

The field events were scored as relays. Schools were allowed to enter up to three athletes per event, with their combined height or distance being used to determine the team standings.

Shoemaker cleared 4-8 to finish first individually, while Provo tied for third at 4-0, and Nutter tied for ninth at 3-8.

The pole vault team of Stella Chlebowski, Karissa Nelson and Skyler Crisman won with a height of 20-0. Chlebowski and Nelson tied for second at 7-0, while Crisman was sixth at 6-0.

The long jump team of Lauren Schuerman, Abigail Stewart and Ava Majzun won with a distance of 41-4³/₄. Schuerman was first at 15-1¹/₄, while Stewart was fourth at 13-4, and Majzun was sixth at 12-11¹/₂.

The 4x100 shuttle hurdles relay team of Chlebowski, Sophia Zunk, Emery Wensink and Nelson won in 1:16.03.

The Eagles' 4x200 relay team broke the school record during its second-place finish. Nelson, Sophie Gillespie, Schuerman and Shoemaker had a time of 1:55.45 to break the record of 1:56.19 set last season.

BOYS RECAP

Eastwood won the 4x800 relay and the pole vault.

The 4x800 team of Noah Bryant, Liam Fiordalisi, Scott McKenzie and Oliver St. Louis won in 9:53.68.

The pole vault team of Everett Ward, Dylan Perkins and Trenton McBride won with a height of 22-6. Ward finished first at 9-0, while Perkins was fifth at 7-0, and McBride tied for sixth at 6-6.
