Boys, girls sweep Otsego, Lake in NBC tri-meet

TONTOGANY — Eastwood High School's girls and boys track and field teams both swept a Northern Buckeye Conference tri-meet Tuesday night.

The boys won 10 of the 17 events and scored 93 points to beat Lake with 59 points and Lake with 23.

The girls won totaled 74½ points, including seven first-places, to beat Otsego with 56½ and Lake with 44.

BOYS RECAP

Cullen Shank won the pole vault, Dayquan Oliver was first in the 200, and Andre Lewis won the 300 hurdles with Eastwood all-time Top 10 performances.

Shank cleared 14-1 to win the pole vault, moving him into sixth place on the Eagles' all-time list. His previous best this season was 14-0 which had put him in a three-way tie for eight on the school's all-time list.

Oliver is eighth all-time in the 200 after he won the event with a time of 22.75. He was a triple winner, also finishing first in the 100 with a time of 11.30 and the long jump with a distance of $20-1\frac{3}{4}$.

Lewis is ninth all-time in the 300 hurdles after he won the event with a time of 40.85. He also won the high jump with a height of 6-0.

Also for the Eagles, Jesse Poiry won the 110 hurdles in 15.45 and Ian Sibbersen won the shot put with a throw of 46-101/4.

Eastwood won two relays.

The 4x100 team of Andre Lewis, Kevin Lewis, Kaiden Sanchez and Wyatt Oestreich won in 45.21.

The 4x800 team of A.J. O'Brien, Austin Miller, Henry Howard and Ben Buehler won in 8:42.78.

GIRLS RECAP

Camille Foos won two events for the Eagles, and Leah Emch, Haley Sponaugle and Kyrie Henline each won once.

Foos won the 800 in 2:28.96 and cleared 5-0 for first place in the high jump.

Leah Emch won the 3,200 in 11:29.61, moving her even closer to the school record in the event. She entered the meet second all-time with a time of 11:32.56 before lowering the time Tuesday. Sarah Lohrbach holds the Eastwood record with a time of 11:25.98 in 1998

Emch also finished second in the 400 in 1:01.82, the eighth-fastest time in school history.

Jenna Gallant broke her school record in the seated shot put for the third time this season with a distance of 9-4, bettering her previous mark by one-half inch.


