

Eagles win 3 events in JV invitational

LUCKEY — Eastwood High School's track and field team won three events Monday in the Eagles' annual junior varsity invitational.

The girls won two events and the boys won one.

No team scores were kept. The top three finishers in each event received medals.

GIRLS RECAP

The Eagles' 4x800 relay team of sophomore Keira Dawson, sophomore

Caitlyn Stiner, and freshmen Mackenzie Chaffee and Brynn Sheets won in 11:05.24. Sophomore Lily Hanneman was the girls' other winner, clearing 4-8 to win the high jump.

Eastwood's Emily Payne finished second in the 3,200 in 13:15.04.

The Eagles had three third-place finishes — freshman Zurie Sanford in the 200, 30.25; junior Bella Provo in the long jump, 14-9½; and the 4x200 relay team of freshman Nadia Angel, freshman Lola Coan, Hanneman and Sanford, 2:03.93.

MaKenna Nelson finished fourth in the 100 hurdles in 18.75 and fifth in the 300 hurdles in 55.08.

Other fourth-place finishers for Eastwood were: Sheets, 800, 2:44.56; Coan, high jump, 4-2; the 4x800 B team of junior Carys Ruck, and sophomores Jade Thornton, August Rubel and Wren Cunningham, 12:49.12; and the 4x400 team of Hanneman, Stiner, Coan and Nelson, 4:50.35.

Eastwood sophomore Jenna Gallant broke her school records in the seated shot put and the seated 100.

Gallant threw 9-6¼ to improve her record for the fourth time this season. Her previous best this season was 9-4. She's in her second season of throwing the shot, with her best mark last season being 8-9¼.

She lowered her record in the 100 with a 39.05 clocking, bettering her previous best this season of 39.94. This is her first season competing in the 100.

BOYS RECAP

Sophomore Braden Dix won the discus for Eastwood, throwing 123-10.

Also, for the Eagles, Cam Schumaker cleared 11-0 to finish second in the pole vault; and sophomore Nolan Taylor finished third in both the 110 hurdles (18.14) and the 300 hurdles (46.41).

Eastwood had three fourth-place finishes — sophomore Steven Nelson in the 110 hurdles, 18.46; junior Sawyer Mason in the high jump, 5-4; and freshman Logan Miesmer in the discus, 111-10.

The Eagles' 4x100 relay team of freshman Bryce Coger, sophomore Owen Recker, junior

Jason Young and Nelson was fifth in 49.58.
